Nod/ Aim:

Bwriad y polisi yw esbonio beth fydd ffocws y cwricwlwm i Gymru yn Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain. Mi fydd yr ysgol yn cynllunio yn erbyn y 6 Maes Dysgu a Phrofiad ond y 4 diben bydd yn gyrru'r cwricwlwm ymlaen gyda'r sgiliau allweddol yn sylfaen i bob agwedd o'r cwricwlwm yn ein hysgol ni.

The intention of this policy is to explain the focus of the Curriculum for Wales at Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain. The school will plan against the Six Areas of Learning and Experience but the 4 purposes will drive the curriculum forward with the key skills underpinning all aspects of the curriculum in our school.

4 Diben y Cwricwlwm / 4 Purposes of the Curriculum:

Mae'n rhaid i gwricwlwm Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain helpu plant a phobl ifanc i weithio tuag at gyflawni'r 4 diben: Mae'r disgyblion wedi dylunio a chreu cymeriad sydd yn dathlu holl elfennau'r 4 diben. Mae Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain wedi ymgorffori'r 4 Diben yn ein hethos a'n gweledigaeth er mwyn sicrhau ein bod yn darparu awyrgylch gofalggar a chynhwysol sy'n dathlu ymdrech a llwyddiant pob unigolyn.

Defnyddiwd disgyblion eu dychymyg a sgiliau creadigiol i ddeall y 4 diben a chreu cymeriadau. Cafwyd eu ysbrydoli gan:

Our curriculum must help children and young people work towards achieving the 4 purposes: The pupils have designed and created a character that celebrates all elements of the 4 purposes. Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain has incorporated the 4 Purposes into our ethos and vision to ensure that we provide a caring atmosphere and inclusiveness that celebrates the effort and success of each individual.

Pupils have used their imagination, creativity and understanding of the 4 purposes to create a special character. The children were inspired by:

Bydd y 4 diben yn cefnogi disgyblion i fod yn/ The 4 purposes will support pupils to become:

- Dysgwyr uchelgeisiol a galluog: Golyga hyn eu bod nhw'n credu ynddyn nhw eu hunain a beth maen nhw'n gallu ei wneud. Maen nhw eisiau dysgu a gwneud yn well. Mae ganddyn nhw'r sgiliau i ddysgu.
- Ambitious and capable learners: This means they believe in themselves and what they can do. They want to learn and do better. They have the skills to learn.



- **Mentrus a chreadigol:** Golyga hyn eu bod nhw'n gallu bod yn greadigol a meddwl am syniadau newydd. Maen nhw'n gallu datrys problemau. Maen nhw'n gallu cymhwyso hyn yn eu gwaith.
- **Enterprising and creative:** This means they can be creative and come up with new ideas. They can solve problems. They can apply this in their work.



- **Dinasyddion egwyddorol a gwybodus:** Golyga hyn eu bod nhw'n deall eu hawliau a'u cyfrifoldebau. Maen nhw'n cymryd rhan yn eu cymuned. Maen nhw'n edrych ar ôl y byd.
- **Ethical, Informed citizens:** This means they understand their rights and responsibilities. They get involved in their community. They look after the world.



- **Iach ac hyderus:** Mae hyn yn meddwl bod ganddyn nhw feddwl a chorff iach. Maen nhw'n teimlo'n dda amdanyn nhw eu hunain ac am beth maen nhw'n gredu.
- **Healthy and confident:** This is thinking that they have a healthy mind and body. They feel good about themselves and what they believe.

As part of our commitment to reducing restrictive practices, bespoke curricular are designed to incorporate positive behaviour management strategies, ensuring that students with additional behavioural needs are supported through individualized learning plans

and de-escalation techniques. Staff are trained to recognize early signs of distress and implement proactive strategies to avoid the use of restraint or exclusion.

6 Maes Dysgu a Phrofiad/ 6 Areas of Learning and Experience:

Yn Ysgol Gynradd Llundain rydym yn sicrhau bod y disgyblion yn derbyn nifer o brofiadau o fewn holl meysydd dysgu a phrofiad y cwricwlwm. Y 6 Maes Dysgu a Phrofiad ydy:

At Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain we ensure that pupils receive a number of experiences within all areas of learning and curriculum experience. The 6 Areas of Learning and Experience are:

1. Y Celfyddydau Mynegiannol/ Expressive Arts

Bydd cyfle i blant a phobl ifanc archwilio'r celfyddydau a dysgu sut i fwynhau a meddwl am gelf pobl eraill. Fe ddylai pob disgybl gael cyfle hefyd i fod yn greadigol. Maen nhw'n gallu dysgu'r pethau yma drwy gymysgedd o wahanol wersi fel:

There will be an opportunity for children and young people to explore the arts and learn how to enjoy and think about the art of others. Every student should also have the chance to be creative. They can learn these things through a mix of different lessons such as:

- Celf/ Art

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- Dawns/ Dance
- Ffilm
- Drama
- Cerddoriaeth/ Music
- Cyfryngau digidol (Golyga cyfryngau digidol unrhyw waith celf rydych chi'n ei greu drwy dechnoleg, er enghraifft, fideo, recordio sain a gwefannau/ Digital media)

2. Iechyd a Lles/ Health and Wellbeing

Dysgu plant a phobl ifanc sut i edrych ar ôl eu iechyd. Golyga hyn:

Teaching children and young people how to take care of their health. This means:

- sicrhau bod ein corff yn iach/ Healthy body
- cadw ein meddwl yn iach/ Healthy mind
- sicrhau perthnasoedd iach gyda phobl/ Healthy relationships
- y gallu i wneud penderfyniadau bywyd da/ The ability to make good life choices

Bydd y cwricwlwm hwn yn cynnwys gweithgareddau megis coginio, chwaraeon a gwersi am lesiant. Diffinir llesiant fel unrhyw beth i'w wneud gyda'ch iechyd a'ch hapusrwydd, yn Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain rydym yn addysgu'r Addysg Personol a Chymdeithasol drwy'r gwrs penodol wythnosol ac yn ystod maes dysgu a phrofiad.

This curriculum will include activities such as cooking, sport and lessons about well-being. Well-being is defined as anything to do with your health and happiness. At Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain, we teach Personal and Social Education through a specific lesson weekly and through the area of learning and experience.

3. Y Dyniaethau/ Humanities

Dysgwn y plant a phobl ifanc i feddwl am y byd er mwyn eu helpu i'w ddeall yn well. Gall hyn fod drwy bynciau fel:

We teach children and young people to think about the world to help them understand it better. This can be through topics such as:

- Hanes/ History
- Daearyddiaeth/ Geography
- Crefyddau, Gwerthoedd a Moeseg/ Religion, Values and Ethics

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4. Ieithoedd, Llythrennedd a Chyfathrebu/ Language, Literacy and Communication

Byddwn yn dysgu plant a phobl ifanc i ddeall a defnyddio gwahanol ieithoedd, gan gynnwys Cymraeg, Saesneg a ieithoedd modern eraill. Ysgol dynodedig Gymraeg yw Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain wedi ei leoli yn Llundain, felly wrth wraidd gweledigaeth yr ysgol mae'r iaith Gymraeg. Rydym yn ei hyrwyddo yn mhob elfen o fywyd a gwaith yr ysgol. Mae disgyblion yn gadael yr ysgol yn ddisgyblion dwyieithog hyderus a balch. Pan yn cyfeirio at Lythrennedd rydym yn ystyried medrau siarad, gwranddo, darllen ac ysgrifennu y disgyblion; medrau sydd yn eu galluogi i wneud synnwyr o'r byd o'n cwrpas ni. Bydd Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain hefyd yn dysgu ein disgyblion i ddeall a gwerthfawrogi llenyddiaeth a chreu eu llenyddiaeth eu hunain. Wrth ystyried llenyddiaeth, rhown gyfle i'r disgyblion brofi a mwynhau llyfrau, cerddi a ffilmiau.

We will teach children and young people to understand and use different languages, including Welsh, English and other modern languages. Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain is a Welsh designated school situated in London so at the heart of the school's vision is the Welsh language. We promote it in all elements of school life and work. Pupils leave school as confident and proud bilingual pupils. When referring to Literacy we consider pupils' speaking, listening, reading and writing skills; skills that enable them to make sense of the world around us. Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain will also teach our pupils to understand and appreciate literature and create their own. When considering literature, we give pupils the opportunity to experience and enjoy books, poems and films.

5. Mathemateg a Rhifedd/ Mathematics and Numeracy

Bydd Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain yn dysgu plant a phobl ifanc i ddeall a defnyddio rhifau. Mae defnyddio rhifau mewn bywyd bob dydd yn cael ei alw yn rhifedd. Fe fydd dysgu am fathemateg a rhifedd yn golygu:

- deall sut mae rhifau'n gweithio.
- deall sut mae symbolau'n gallu cael eu defnyddio a beth maen nhw'n feddwl.
- deall sut i fesur pethau a gweithio gyda gwahanol siapiau.
- deall sut i gasglu gwybodaeth gan ddefnyddio'r wybodaeth yma i wneud penderfyniadau.

Ysgol Gymraeg Llundain will teach children and young people to understand and use numbers. The use of numbers in everyday life is called numeracy. Learning about maths and numeracy will mean:

- Understand how numbers work.
- understand how symbols can be used and what they think.
- understand how to measure things and work with different shapes.
- understand how to gather information using this information to make decisions.

Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg/ Science and Technology

Byddwn yn dysgu plant a phobl ifanc i ddeall natur a phethau byw. Rhaid iddyn nhw ddysgu am y grymoedd o'n cwmpas. Grymoedd ydy pethau dydych chi ddim yn gallu eu gweld sydd yn effeithio arnoch chi, fel disgyrchiant. Byddwn hefyd yn dysgu plant a phobl ifanc am sut mae technoleg yn gweithio i ddatrys problemau. Mae hyn yn gallu bod drwy bynciau fel bioleg, cemeg, ffiseg a gwyddoniaeth cyfrifiadurol.

We will teach children and young people to understand nature and living things. They must learn about the forces around us. Forces are things you can't see that affect you, like gravity. We will also teach children and young people about how technology works to solve problems. This can be through subjects such as biology, chemistry, physics and computer science.

Themâu Trawsgwricwlaidd neu Sgiliau ar gyfer y cwricwlwm cyfan: bydd yr athrawon yn cynllunio er mwyn sicrhau bod pob pwnc yn datblygu'r sgiliau traws-gwricwlaidd isod:

- Sgiliau llythrennedd – gwrando, siarad, darllen ac ysgrifennu.
- Sgiliau rhifedd – deall a defnyddio rhifau.
- Sgiliau digidol – gallu dysgu a deall technoleg. Golyga hyn y gallu i ddefnyddio dyfeisiadau digidol fel cyfrifiaduron, ffonau deallus a thabledi. Bydd y sgiliau uchod yn allweddol at lwyddiant pob blentyn er mwyn iddynt gael y mynediad gorau posib i'r Cwricwlwm i Gymru.

Cross-Curricular Themes or Skills for the whole curriculum: teachers will plan to ensure that all subjects develop the following cross-curricular skills:

- Literacy skills – listening, speaking, reading and writing.
- Numeracy skills – understanding and using numbers.
- Digital skills – being able to learn and understand technology. This means the ability to use digital devices such as computers, smartphones and tablets. The above skills will be key to every child's success so that they have the best possible access to the Curriculum for Wales.

Sgiliau ehangach i'w hystyried wrth gynllunio:

- Cynllunio a Threfnu - sicrhau atebion a gweithredu syniadau
- Creadigrwydd ac Arloesedd - archwilio syniadau a mynegi barn
- Effeithiolrwydd Personol - ymddwyn mewn modd effeithiol a phriodol

Broader skills to consider when planning:

Critical thinking and problem solving - adopt logical and critical processes to analyze and understand situations

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- Planning and Organising - securing solutions and implementing ideas
- Creativity and Innovation - exploring ideas and expressing opinions
- Personal Effectiveness - behave in an effective and appropriate manner

Sut bydd modd cyflawni'r uchod?

Yn gyntaf, bydd yr athrawon yn cynllunio'n ofalus yn erbyn themâu sydd yn galluogi'r ysgol i gyrraedd cydbwysedd o ran y chwe maes dysgu a phrofiad. Yma, rhoddir pwyslais ar ddatblygu a chyfoethogi medrau iaith a Mathemateg y disgyblion er mwyn iddyn nhw gymhwyso y medrau hyn yn hyderus yn draws-gwricwlaidd yn y chwe maes dysgu a phrofiad. Bydd disgwyl i lechyd a llesiant ymddangos yn glir yn y cynllunio ac wrth ystyried Dyniaethau, Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg a Chelfyddydau Mynegiannol bydd hi'n bosib i ddewis thema gyda thuedd tuag at faes dysgu a phrofiad arbennig e.e. Dyniaethau gan astudio'r ardal leol, Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg gan ystyried dyfeisiadau ayyb. Bydd llais y disgybl yn allweddol yn y broses gynllunio.

How will the above be achievable?

First, the teachers will plan carefully against themes that enable the school to reach a balance of the six areas of learning and experience. Here, emphasis will be placed on developing and enriching pupils' Language and Maths skills so that they can confidently apply these skills cross-curricular in the six areas of learning and experience. Health and wellbeing will be expected to feature prominently in the planning and when considering Humanities, Science and Technology and Expressive Arts it will be possible to choose a theme with a trend towards a particular area of learning and experience e.g. Humanities studying the local area, Science and Technology taking into account inventions etc. The pupil's voice will be key in the planning process.


Pupil's Voice

Keeping the Policy Up to Date:

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- 2 This policy is a constantly amending policy, it is essential to allow adaptation and change to truly take advantage of the flexibility of Curriculum for Wales. The research of the school and beyond will add to the experiences of teachers and pupils. We motivate our teachers to take a risk in order to excite and reform the pedagogy. However, when taking a risk, the basic expectations of the curriculum remain high.
